
Dear Parents/Carers,

We hope everyone had a happy and peaceful Easter holiday, and bank holiday weekend. All the children worked so hard during the Spring Term and so, were ready for the break. It's great to see them back and refreshed ready for our final term in Year 4. We still have much to do before the holidays and are looking forward to it!


Summer Term Curriculum

<u>English:</u> This term we will be basing our study on two texts: Varjak Paw & Secrets of a Sun-King. I am excited to share both of these books with the children- we have begun Varjak and are hooked already! As well as practising our reading skills using the texts, we will be basing our writing on them too. The many grammatical terms and techniques



we learn in Year 4 will be applied in this writing. In reading, we are focusing on retrieving and inferring from the text and considering the vocabulary used by authors. This will, in turn, support our writing, so be prepared for your children to be surprising you with their rich vocabulary!

<u>Maths:</u> In maths, we are building on previous terms' learning on decimals including ordering, comparing and rounding. We are securing a sound understanding of the place value system which underpins our knowledge of number. We will also be studying angles and short division. Each day we will be practising our times tables so that we have rapid recall of all the tables up to X12. We are continuing to use the Supermovers songs for this and the



Topmarks website, all of which are available online. Please do try to practise these tables with your child daily: activities could include counting in 3s,4s,5s etc, quickfire questions and writing out multiplication facts and inverse division fact.

<u>RE:</u> After completing our Easter unit, we will continue to learn more about Moses, his relationship with God and what 'vocation' means. We will also explore the units of Pentecost, other Christian faiths and traditions, and unpick some of the roles and responsibilities in Church.

<u>Science:</u> We are finishing our unit on Living Things & their habitats- the children will love to tell you about us exploring the school grounds, on an invertebrate hunt, and all that they found! After this, we will begin our unit on Electricity, and througout the term will focus on working scientifically.

Everything Egypt: This term our unit incorporating History, Geography, Art, D&T and Computing will be on Egypt. We will begin by locating Egypt on a map and learning about significant places there. In History, we will study Ancient Egypt including the Gods, Tutankhamen, hieroglyphs and gain an understanding of life during this period. Complementing this, we will study Egyptian Art and Akenaten, and design and make a pharaoh mask. In Computing, we are using Publisher software to create fact-files on Egyptian Gods. Our English text, Secrets of a Sun-King , is also based on this unit. We are looking forward to getting into Everything Egypt!



<u>P.E:</u> This term the children will be having Cricket sessions with Warwickshire cricket; they have already enjoyed a day at a cricket festival this term. Some of our children will also be continuing with their swimming lessons on a Tuesday whilst the rest of us practise Yoga and focus on Dance.

Please ensure your child has the relevant P.E. kit in school at all times & swimming kit, if appropriate, on a Tuesday
