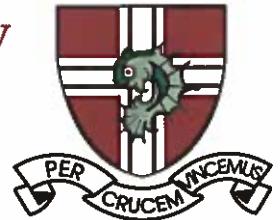

ANNUAL SPORTS DAY – THURSDAY 13 JULY 2017

Our annual Sports Day is being held on Thursday 13 July 2017 at Princess Mary Athletic Track, Spenborough, Cleckheaton. As you are aware, this is a major event for our school community, as it epitomises the endeavour and camaraderie that we hold in such high regard at St John Fisher. In addition to the student's House Competition, there will be a number of staff events to ensure that the day is highly enjoyable for all members of our community.

Attendance is compulsory for all. Pupils should arrive at the stadium in PE kit (white PE t-shirt, black shorts, white and red socks) ready to register at **9.00am**. Staff will be present from 8.50am, any pupils not appropriately dressed will be segregated. Those travelling on school buses will be picked up at normal time and will be supervised on arrival at the stadium. **For those who normally walk to school, there will be a bus to take you to the track, the bus will be leaving school at 8.30am.**

Pupils will require warm clothing to wear when not participating in their event. Sandwich lunches will be available to purchase at the track or a packed lunch should be provided. A meal will be provided for those entitled to free school meals. The day will finish with a registration at approximately **2.30pm**. No pupil will be allowed to leave the track until they are formally dismissed. School buses will pick up from the stadium.

If you are picking your child up by car, please be aware there is limited parking in and around the stadium. We ask all parents to exercise extreme caution at the end of the day particularly those leaving the small car park where pedestrians and motor vehicles will be in close proximity.

It is important that all pupils come prepared for the day with water to drink and if it is a sunny day, with a hat and sun cream.

Parental support on the day is welcome. For safety reasons adults or family members will not be allowed entry without a ticket and movement will need to be restricted within the stadium. Any parents or family members who want to attend the event can apply for tickets by completing the attached reply slip. Please state the **NAME** of the person attending as it will be necessary to check names against our admissions list. All students need to return their reply slip directly to **the PE office** by Monday 10 July, whether their parents require tickets or not.

PLEASE NOTE THIS SPORTS DAY IS A COMPULSORY SCHOOL DAY AND ALL PUPILS MUST ATTEND.
