Anticipated transport costs for 2017/18

In catchment £300 (£20 deposit followed by 7 payments of £40). *This charge will be applicable to any student joining the academy from Year 7 to 11 from autumn term 2017/18*

Out of catchment £360 (£45 deposit followed by 7 payments of £45)

Post 16 £600 (£75 deposit followed by 7 payments of £75)

Any students in receipt of Free School Meals will be offered transport at a reduced rate.

Post 16 students eligible for the P16 Bursary should complete the bursary application form stating that you require assistance with transport costs. *(Eligibility for the bursary is household income below £25,000)*

FAQ

Q: Why are in catchment students being charged for transport?

A: Since the introduction of the local authorities transport policy the academy has supported transport for its in catchment pupils. These costs have continued to rise year on year to a level that has become unsustainable. Although we are having to charge for transport the academy will continue to contribute towards transport costs for the foreseeable future to reduce parental costs. Without additional funding from central government and whilst working to the best of our endeavours with the restraints placed upon us, the academy has to charge for transport.

Q: My child is currently a student at the academy and receives free transport, will this continue?

A: Yes until they reach Post 16. All Post 16 students have to pay for transport.

Q: My child is in receipt of Free School Meals who do I speak to about transport costs?

Q: Bosworth Academy is my nearest school but I leave more than 3 miles away, will I receive free transport.

A: Yes you will and this will be provided by the local authority, but your child may travel on one of the academy buses.

Q: How do I apply for a place on the school bus?

A: When your child's place is confirmed at the academy you will be sent an application form for transport.
