

## How parents can support their child?

- Discuss and recap concepts covered in class
- Encourage extra revision once HWK complete
- Encourage sensible bedtimes
- Stress and encourage responsibilities of students
- Get other family members to provide support - who are currently doing/have done GCSEs
- Ask what homework is set and when and monitor how this is completed
- Help with revision - e.g. verbal tests/conversations
- Purchase revision guides e.g. Maths Watch and memorise
- Take students on trips
- Provide homework strategies and guidance - e.g. do on the day set, draft timetables
- Take away distractions e.g. electronic devices
- Pick up from interventions
- Provide work spaces at home
- Check homework
- Allow access to their computers for students to work on
- Ask questions about homework
- Check the students know their intervention timetable and attend these sessions
- Provide positive encouragement
- Pay for a specific subject tutor
- Explain homework tasks if students are unsure
- Ensure that students know the importance of GCSEs
- Encourage of effort and good attitude to learning
- Check/help with punctuation and grammar
- Make packed lunches
- Congratulate successes
- Purchased equipment
- Make sure that their children are healthy
