



## Trinity School Examinations Report 2018

2018 was the first year that students sat GCSE exams at Trinity school. All examinations were graded with the new 9-1 measure with the exception of Economics, Business Studies and Design Technology.

### Headlines

- Strong progress across for students regardless of their starting points which is exemplified by positive P8 scores
- The attainment 8 score for the school was 48.6 indicating an average grade of 5 for all students across all their subjects
- 68% of students achieved a standard pass (grade 4 or above) in Maths and English
- 46% of students achieved a strong pass (grade 5 or above) in Maths and English
- 69% of students achieved a strong pass in English with 50% achieving a strong pass in maths
- 27% of students achieved the English Baccalaureate (at least a grade 5 in English, mathematics, a modern language, Science and a humanities subject)
- 14% students achieved 5 or more grade 7, 8 or 9s (equivalent to A or A\* grades)
