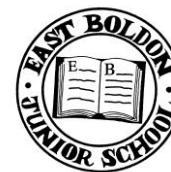

New Year Soccer Camp

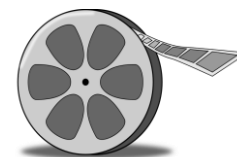
