If it is a longer discussion that is needed then the teachers will be available and have more time at the end of the day. You are always welcome to ring up and make an appointment to ensure the teacher is available.

We were concerned about the number of offensive and inaccurate comments that were placed on facebook over the weekend about the school and pupils. Although this was a very small number of parents we felt we needed to remind all parents about the legal implications which you can read on the facebook letter on the website.
