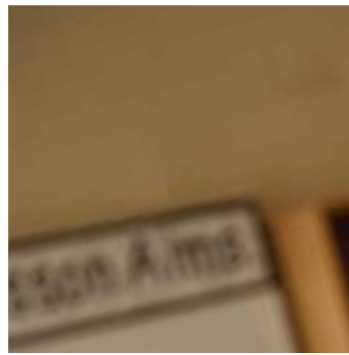

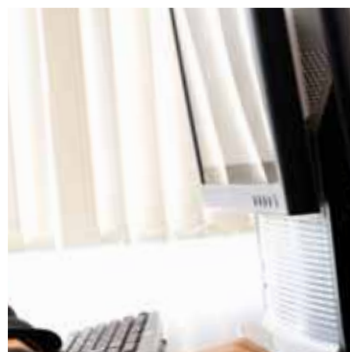
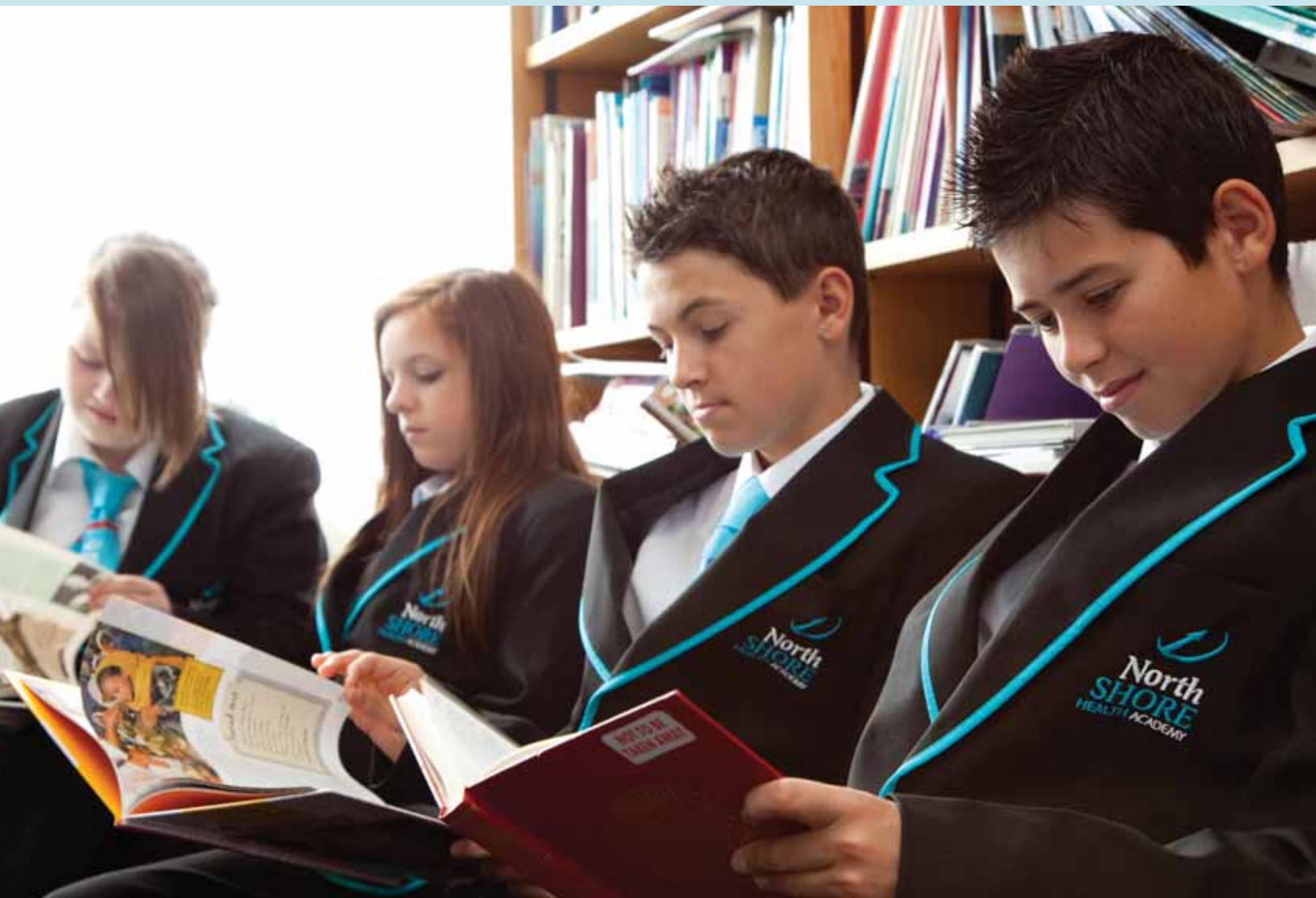


Climate for learning
