Year Group	Event	Details
8	Resilience training	Identified groups in year 8 will receive resilience training throughout the academic year. Problem based activities and challenges will be set and coaching will be available to develop coping and resilience skills.
8	Reach for the future	Year 8 groups linked to the Positive Steps project will participate in an employer led session in June. In groups, students will use their resilience training to overcome different challenges.
8	Humanitarianism Workshop	Workshops delivered by Manchester University to give students an insight into working in disaster relief.
9	Industry Day	All year 9 will participate in the annual industry day on 24 <sup>th</sup> Jan. Local employers will set team challenges and awards will be presented to the top 3.
9	Options Interviews	For all students and families who request an options interview after the option evening. These typically take place in March.
10	Careers Fair	Wednesday 18 <sup>th</sup> October. Local colleges, training providers and the armed forces will be present. Careers information for all year 10 students including progression routes, entry qualifications and courses.
10	University Challenge	Hosted by Ashton 6 <sup>th</sup> form college, Year 10 students will compete against other schools in Tameside.
10	Inspirational Education	University workshops delivered by Bolton University and Bury College.
10	CHOICES (Formally called Skills North West)	All year 10 will visit the CHOICES event in March. Colleges, universities, training providers, employers etc, will all be on hand to offer advice and guidance on a wide range of courses and careers. Students can collect information, application forms and take part in hands on activities.

10	XL Challenge	Ashton 6 <sup>th</sup> form will again host this October event. An XL presentation will be made on how local colleges will challenge and stretch students aiming for grades A/A*
10	University visit	Manchester University
10	College Taster Days	In July all students in year 10 will take part in taster sessions at either Tameside College, Clarendon 6 <sup>th</sup> Form or Ashton 6 <sup>th</sup> Form. The sessions will enable students to sample different courses and also to experience the differences between academic and vocational qualifications.
11	Careers Fair	Wednesday 18 <sup>th</sup> October. Local colleges, training providers and the armed forces will be present. Careers information for all year 11 students including progression routes, entry qualifications and courses.
11	Mock Interviews	In preparation for college interviews, all year 11 will take part in mock interviews on 9 <sup>th</sup> November. These will be led by local employers and all students will receive written feedback on their performance.

- The school activity day will take part in June (TBA). All students will have the opportunity to broaden their horizons by going on a trip of their choice and taking part in a range of activities run by different organisations. These include Barclays Bank, British Military Fitness, National Apprenticeships and GM Higher.
- National careers week takes place in March and further events will be added to the calendar as and when they are announced by our partners.
- GM Higher Events take place throughout the academic year for specific year groups. These will be announced when dates are finalized.

All KS4 students will have access to the careers software 'Fast Tomato'. Students will receive training on how to use this package in their bespoke careers lessons.
