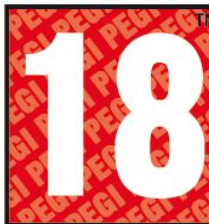
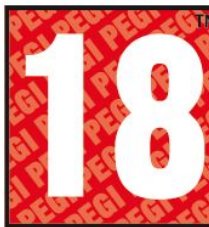

The PEGI labels appear on a game's packaging to show what age group the game is suitable for.

They also have descriptors which indicate the main reasons why a game has a particular age rating.
