British Values



Democracy

- **Democracy** – as an understanding of how citizens can influence decision-making through the democratic process

In groups how can we as citizens influence decision making?

Rule of Law

- **Rule of Law** – an appreciation that living under the rule of law **protects individual citizens and is essential for their wellbeing and safety**; an understanding that there is a **separation** of power between the executive and the judiciary, and that while some public bodies such as the police and the army can be held to account through Parliament, others such as the **courts maintain independence**.

Why is this important in our society?

Individual Liberty

An understanding that the freedom to choose and hold other faiths and beliefs is protected in law.

Would it matter if this was not protected in law?

Mutual respect and tolerance of others with different beliefs and values

An acceptance that other people having different faiths or beliefs to oneself (or having none) should be **accepted and tolerated**, and should not be the cause of prejudicial or discriminatory behaviour; an understanding of the **importance of identifying and combatting discrimination**
