Following the success of last year's school calendar I am writing to inform you of our new photographic competition.

- Students from years 7-13 and staff have until **Tuesday 22nd November** submit scenic photographs of the North East of England for entry into the competition.
- Staff are also invited to take part
- **The winning photographs will feature in the 2012 Whickham School and Sports College Calendar.**
- **Proceeds from the calendar support the school's charity project.**
- The competition is being supported by local businesses and the Parents' Forum.

Please note the following guidelines:

- Each student may submit a maximum of 3 photographs.
- The photographs should each be 7" x 5" (approximately 18cm x 12.5cm).
- **We prefer photographs to be from a digital format** (if you do not have access to a digital camera you can still enter. Speak to the receptionist for further information).
- Please keep/save the original digital image (if you win we may need to work with the digital image!). You can pick up the official envelopes in which to place your entry from reception.
- **Photographs are to be submitted to the reception desk or main office before registration, at break time or after school.**
- **Students will need to fill in the details of the photographs on the envelope available from reception**
- The photographs must be taken by you.
- The photos will be judged by a combination of students, staff and parents. The judges will not know who took the photographs.
- **The photos must not contain people** - they must be scenes of the North East and you will have to name the location/locations on the entry envelope and reverse side of the photograph.
- We will be unable to return the photographs but they could feature in future school displays.
- Each photograph should contain a scene from the North East that would be appropriate for the school calendar. If you have any queries please contact Mr Grimes.
