This course gives students an opportunity to study a vocational qualification investigating the travel and tourism sector. Students need to study a combination of 4 units. Of these four one is examined and the other three are internally assessed continually throughout the course.

Students will be awarded a Distinction \*, Distinction, Merit or pass at Level 2. This is equivalent to a passing grade at GCSE. If students are unsuccessful at Level 2 they are still eligible for a Level 1 pass.
