


# Summer Newsletter 2016

Dear Parents and Carers

We hope you have all had a relaxing Easter break, it's lovely the children are back at school this week, full of smiles and enthusiasm.

Our topic this half term is 'Space'. In literacy we will continue to be working on our communication, BSL, reading and writing or we will be reading a variety of non-fiction books linked to space exploration. We will also be making our own books linked to space and are going to be linking our literacy with Kelly, our artist in residence making lots of resources to create a role play area and then writing stories about what we have created. Poppy our SaLT is continuing to work with us in individual sessions and smiLE programme and also in class supporting us in our expressive and receptive skills lessons where we are making steady progress in developing our understanding of the question 'who does what?'



In maths we will continue working at our own individual pace with our knowledge of number and shape space and measure. We will also be looking at repeated addition, simple multiplication and number sentences using both practical and written activities. In science we will be looking at what plants need to grow. We will be continuing our sessions in food technology; will be continuing to choose foods that are healthy to eat by making a variety of healthy snacks e.g. sandwiches/picnic food.

Sarah will continue to teach us for our RE, art and humanities sessions where we will be exploring Islam. We will also be looking at transport, travel and leisure in our humanities work and plan to visit lots of local amenities to see this first hand. In art we will also be looking at making transport different types of transport using different materials and construction techniques using both 2D and 3D models.
