

**ARCHDIOCESE OF BIRMINGHAM
PARISH BOUNDARIES
SAINT CHRISTOPHER, CODSALL, STAFFS**

Interpretation of Boundaries:

1. A house or institution belongs to the parish holding the road or side of the road into which opens its principal entrance.
2. A cul-de-sac, crescent, etc., having official opening(s) only onto one road belongs to the parish holding the road or side of the road having such official opening(s), unless the contrary be expressly stated.
3. The boundary always follows the middle of roads, lanes, footpaths, rivers, etc., unless stated otherwise.

Starting in the north-west at the point where the Diocesan Boundary touches the road from Codsall Wood to Bishops Wood and Boscobel about ½ mile north of Whitehouse Lane

1. South along the ROAD TO CODSALL WOOD to Whitehouse Lane (both sides);
2. East along WHITEHOUSE LANE and its continuations, passing White House, Leper House and Gunstone Hall Farm, crossing the Brewood Road and continuing along PENDEFORD HALL LANE to the Shropshire Union Canal at Upper Hattons Bridge (both sides all the way);
3. South along the SHROPSHIRE UNION CANAL for about 1 mile to Ballard's Brook;
4. South-west along BALLARD'S BROOK, passing under Pendeford Road, Codsall Road, Keepers Lane and Wergs Hall Road, through the grounds of Wergs Hall to the Wergs Road/Holyhead Road;
5. East along HOLYHEAD ROAD / WERGS ROAD (A 41) to the junction with Yew Tree Lane and Westcroft Road (neither side);
6. South along YEW TREE LANE and MILL LANE to Perton Road (neither side, thus excluding specifically Wrottesley Road West and Westcroft Road);
7. West along PERTON ROAD to Wrottesley Park Road (neither side);
8. North along WROTTESLEY PARK ROAD, passing west of the Perton Estate, to the Lane to Cranmoor Lodge;
9. North-west along the LANE TO CRANMOOR LODGE and continuing along the OLD ROAD past Bradshaw's Farm, Simmonds Wood and Kingswood Bank Farm to the Shifnal Road;
10. West along the SHIFNAL ROAD (A 464) to the Diocesan Boundary;
11. North along the DIOCESAN BOUNDARY to the Road from Codsall Wood to Bishops Wood
