**Kenilworth Castle GCSE History Visit
Thursday 11th October 2018**

There will be a day trip for all Year 11 pupils studying GCSE History to visit Kenilworth Castle. This is a trip to aid their studies of a local historical site, a section of the course, which will be examined at the end of Year 11.
