Mission at Home – Saturday 26 January – Sunday 27 January 2019

Your child has been invited to take part in The Mission at Home Project at St Peter and St Paul's, Giffard House, Wolverhampton.

The purpose of the trip is to give young adults the opportunity to serve others by taking part in a social action project in their local community. This event is being organised by the Kenelm Trust, part of Birmingham Catholic Youth Service and Archdiocese of Birmingham. I will be staying with the children for the duration.

The trip will involve young adults helping the Brothers of the Good Shepherd making care packages, cleaning, serving at a soup kitchen, helping the elderly with shopping, sleeping over in a sleeping bag, like the homeless, at St Peter's and Paul's on the Saturday night in Giffard House. On Sunday we will conclude with a Celebration of World Youth Day Mass, with words from Pope Francis Panamanian Cuisine. The Mass will start at 7.00am. We will be joined by young adults from across the Diocese and we would like to extend this invitation to you.

The event starts at 4.00pm on Saturday 26th January at St Peter's and St Paul's so I would like your child to meet me there at 3.45pm. We aim to be finished for around 8.30 – 9.00am on Sunday 27th January. If you do not attend the mass arrangements should be made for your child to be collected for their journey home.

There is no cost to the trip however, I ask that you encourage your child to get as many sponsors as they can for their sleepover. All money raised will be donated to the Table House which is a night shelter for the homeless.

Your child will be required to:

- Bring a sleeping bag (matt or pillow if needed)
- Wear warm clothing (there are no shower facilities and food will be provided throughout the weekend)
- Bring any medication they may need (inhalers etc.) clearly labelled and given to Mrs Ferris
