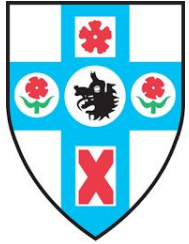

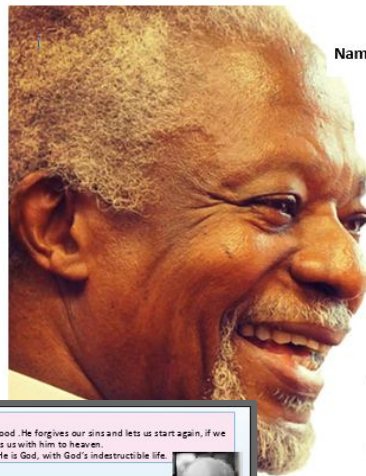

Religious Education Y7: The Saviour

Key words:

**Saviour:** The One who is to save us from sin.

**Missionary:** someone who goes out to preach and teach about Jesus.

**Sabbath:** the day of rest; seventh day of the week (Saturday for Jews, Sunday for Christians).

**Pharisee:** a member of a strict sect of Jews who follow all Jewish Laws and customs.

**Repent(ance):** turning to God and being truly sorry.

**Beatitudes:** meaning 'blessings'. Jesus' values given in the Sermon on the Mount.

**Sermon:** a talk or lecture on a religious or moral theme.



- John the Baptist preached in these words: "Repent for the Kingdom of God is close at hand".
- He meant that the rule of God was coming. People should be clean from sin and ready to follow God.

How does Jesus save us?  
Jesus is saving us all the time. During our life, He gives us His spirit, to help us do good. He forgives our sins and lets us start again, if we do sin. After we die, he gives us picks us up, and takes us with him to heaven. He can do all this, because sin has no power over him, and because He is God, with God's indestructible life.

for they shall obtain mercy.

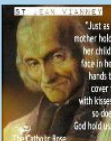
Blessed are the pure in heart:
