## **Uniform from September 2018**

Thank you for your support at the start of term to ensure that our student uniform meets the high standards we expect on campus. The vast majority of students are now wearing a school jumper or cardigan as per the changes to our uniform policy since the start of term.

We realise that there have been some problems with uniform orders but we can assure you that all student jumpers will be delivered by the end of September.

### **Jumpers and cardigans**

**As of 1 October it will be compulsory for all students to arrive at school wearing their school jumper or cardigan.** If they arrive without this item of uniform they will be issued with a 'standards (pink) slip' where they will have to complete a detention. We are applying the same policy towards the jumper and cardigan that we do currently with the tie. Students may also be asked to wear a spare school jumper or cardigan if they come without one.

### **Coats and jackets**

As the weather gets cooler all students must come to school wearing a warm and weatherproof coat suitable for walking to and from the campus as well as between the buildings.

Non-uniform sweatshirts, hoodies, lightweight sports tops and denim jackets are not classed as coats and should not be brought to school as they are not suitable for the cooler weather.

If you are having any problems with your uniform order please inform the campus well in advance of the 1 October deadline.
