Dear Parents/Carer

A Level Geography Field Trip 9 -10 October 2018

In order to fulfil the exam board requirements, your child is required to complete four full days of field enquiry; two in the human environment and two in the physical environment. **Two of the four trips** will be a coastal enquiry along the Norfolk coast examining Coastal processes and Management in Cromer and Sheringham, as well as investigating the impacts of coastal erosion in smaller villages along the coast.

This will be an overnight trip staying in the Sheringham Youth Hostel on Tuesday 9th October. We will leave school at 3.30pm on Tuesday 9th and aim to be back between 19:00 - 19:30 on Wednesday 10th. However, this is dependent on traffic and students will need to make their own arrangements to get to and from campus.

Students will need to be well prepared with warm, waterproof clothing, and suitable footwear (Wellingtons if possible and I highly recommend a change of footwear and socks). They will also need an overnight bag and any toiletries and towels they may need. The Youth Hostel is booked on **Bed and Breakfast** basis so students will need some extra cash for evening meal on the Tuesday and lunch on the Wednesday. Students should bring water to drink and any extra snacks they require. There will be opportunities for students to visit local shops.

The cost of the trip will be £60 to pay for the minibus, cover and accommodation; it is non-refundable.

Payments should be made online, using a debit or credit card, by logging on to the ParentPay website. As part of this online process you will also

- **be giving consent for your child to attend the trip**
- **give permission for group leaders to make any medical decisions that might arise if necessary**
- **need to provide medical information, dietary requirements, and any other relevant details.**
