TRIP TO WEMBLEY – ENGLAND MATCH FRIDAY 22 MARCH 2019

We are organising a trip to Wembley to watch the England versus Czech Republic Mens European Championship International football match on Friday 22nd March. In the first instance we are inviting students who have regularly represented the school in our football teams this year in years 7 to 10 to apply for tickets as a reward for their service to the school.

We will be leaving school at approximately 3.30pm for a 7.45pm kick off. We would expect to return to campus by approximately 1.00am on the morning of Saturday 23rd March. Students will therefore need to be collected from campus at that time.

We expect this to be a popular trip and, in the event that it is oversubscribed, preference will be given to students who have fewer than 10 behaviour points and an attendance of above 94%. In the event that the trip remains oversubscribed after these criteria have been applied a ballot will take place to award tickets. If places remain on the trip following this time they will be offered to other students in school.

The cost for the visit, to include return coach travel and entry ticket, will be £28 per student. If you would like your son / daughter to take part in this trip please give your consent and make the online payment by **Wednesday 6 February. All those that have paid will then be eligible for a place under the criteria described above.**

Students will need to bring either a packed tea or money to purchase food, either at motorway services or at Wembley itself. We are asked by Wembley Stadium to point out that the Family Stand enclosures are steeply tiered and tickets may not be suitable for those who suffer from vertigo.

Places will be notified to students by Friday 8 February. Refunds back to parentpay accounts will be arranged for those students who were unsuccessful in being allocated a place.
