Dear Parent/Carers,

Geography Tour to Iceland 2019

The Geography department is excited to be proposing a school trip to Iceland to support our GCSE curriculum and enhance learning experiences within the school. It is designed to complement topics covered in GCSE Geography lessons and Science courses.

The trip includes proposed visits to the Secret Lagoon, in Fludir a mineral rich geothermal spa; Pingvellir National Park, the site of Iceland's parliament in A.D. 930; we will visit the stunning waterfalls at Gullfoss; travel to the Solheimajokull glacier, where we will do a glacier walk; we will also visit Volcano Hekla. Students will spend time in the capital City of Reykjavik and visit the Hveragerdi Greenhouse village and Geothermal Power Plant.

The proposed date of this trip is the 23rd – 26th February 2019. We will fly from a London airport to Reykjavik, where we will stay in the Cabin Hotel Reykjavik on a full board basis.

The cost of this trip will be £795, although this might alter slightly due to numbers. This will include:

- Return flights. A private coach for tours and transfers.
- A professional English speaking guide for the duration of the trip.
- Accommodation – 3 nights in a hotel (full board).
- Insurance. Secret Lagoon entrance and towels.
- Hellisheidi Power Plant exhibition.
- Kerid Crater entrance.
- Glacier walk.

A £100.00 non-refundable deposit should be paid via ParentPay by the 7th February 2018 to secure your child's place on this trip, unless there are insufficient numbers to make it viable. A further £100.00 will be required in June 2018. The final payment will then be due in November 2018. Your child will require a current passport and EHIC card.

This trip is open to all Year 8 and Year 9/10 Geography students and could prove to be a popular choice. Therefore if more than 30 applications are made Year 9 & 10 students will be given the opportunity of a place first. As trip organisers we reserve the right to not include pupils on the visit where we feel there could be a risk to safety or a challenge to authority. This will be fully discussed with Mr Gray should a decision have to be made.
