I am writing to inform you of a number of changes that we are making to the way in which we run after school detentions. Firstly there are very few pupils who are placed in an after school detention. There are many reasons why a pupil may be placed into an after school detention and we do not take the decision lightly.

The current system is that a child will serve the detention on a Wednesday night from 3:05-4:05, this will remain the same. The changes that we are going to make are that if a pupil does not attend and does not bring a letter into school prior to the day the detention is set, stating why they are unable to attend the detention, then the following day the pupil will be out of lessons, in a room with a senior member of staff and will have break and lunch time at different time to other pupils.

This new way of working will help us to maintain outstanding behaviour and standards at Studley High School.
