## Imperial War Museum Trip- Monday 3rd December 2018

I am writing to you to highlight a fantastic opportunity for your child. The History Department will be organising a visit to the Imperial War Museum in London on Monday 3rd December 2018 for Year 11 GCSE History pupils.

The Museum deals with conflict in the world during the 20<sup>th</sup> Century and we will be primarily concerned with the events of the Holocaust and the First World War. The visit supports the work we have previously done on Nazi Germany and the Western Front, both of which are GCSE examined units. Due to the sensitive nature of the Holocaust exhibition the museum provides briefing and debriefing workshops as part of the programme.

The trip will leave Studley on **Monday 3rd December 2018** at **7.00am** returning by **6.00pm**. Pupils should wear school uniform and bring a packed lunch. There is a gift shop at the museum, so if students wish to purchase any gifts/souvenirs then a maximum of £10 is recommended.

The cost of the trip will be **£24**, which covers the Imperial War Museum educational sessions, audio guides and the cost of transport. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium funding, the cost of the trip is reduced to **£20**. The preferred payment method for this trip is via ParentPay. If you already use ParentPay, this trip will be visible to make a payment towards. If you experience any difficulty with ParentPay or have not registered and would like to do so, please contact the School Finance Department. Please note the museum will only allow us to take a group of 60 pupils at any one time so the trip is limited in spaces. If the trip is oversubscribed then places will be drawn randomly and you shall be notified of place allocation.

If you would like your child to attend this educational visit, please pay £24 (or £20 for Pupil Premium students) via the ParentPay system and tick the permission box to give your consent. The deadline for payment is **Monday 26th November 2018**. Please note the payment is non-refundable unless the trip needs to be cancelled due to lack of interest, in which case payments will be returned. Behaviour will be considered when selecting pupils to attend this trip and we reserve the right to remove any child if we have behavioural/safety concerns.
