SCHOOL UNIFORM 2018/19 - GIRLS

All clothing and equipment must be clearly marked with owner's name, and preferably with woven name tapes.

Please read the uniform list carefully and endeavour to supply your daughter with the correct clothing. As you know we have a smart school uniform and try very hard to maintain high standards, but we can only do this with your support. If you are not sure about any of the uniform or hairstyles, please contact school for advice. Thank you.

Please note there is only **one** standard style of skirt and available from the school suppliers. Students can wear either a skirt or trousers.

- BLAZER** Maroon blazer with crest. Compulsory for Year 7-10
- SKIRT** Official Shevington High tartan skirt (available from stockist below)
- TROUSERS** Black school style trousers – NO fashion trousers including cords, jeans or tight cuts
- BLOUSES** Year's 7-10- blue school shirt to be worn with school tie.
Year 11- white shirt
- JUMPER** Optional long-sleeved Shevington High School jumper in maroon with gold lines around the V neck. Year 7-10

Compulsory long-sleeved Shevington High School jumper in black with gold band around the V neck with an SHS Logo. Year 11
- SOCKS/
TIGHTS** Plain black knee length socks or plain black opaque tights.
- SHOES** Plain black flat heeled shoes of a sensible style please refer to our website for styles. Trainers, boots or other fashion footwear are not permitted. If in doubt, please contact the school to avoid wasting money.
- COAT** Single coloured waterproof coat/jacket. (No leather, imitation leather, waxed jackets or corduroy). No fashion jackets, hooded tops or tracksuit tops. No large writing or logos. The coat must fit over the blazer.
- HEADGEAR** Hood attached to coats. In extremely cold weather a plain woollen hat may be worn. (No football hats or baseball caps.) Outside the building only.
- HAIR** Hair below shoulder length will need to be tied back at all times. In order to maintain the school's reputation for high standards of appearance the rules on hairstyles are:
- **NO EXTREME HAIRSTYLES**
 - Hair must be kept neat; any ribbons or slides must be of a reasonable colour for school uniform.
 - Hair should be of a natural and uniform colour. No distinct lines or steps are acceptable.
 - No shaved heads.
- Any parent who is uncertain about whether a style or colour is acceptable or not should contact school for advice.**
- JEWELLERY/** No jewellery is allowed. No piercings are allowed. If your child wishes to have pierced ears,

A plain wrist watch may be worn.

Students should **not** wear make-up or nail polish. Students will be asked to remove makeup/nail polish during registration if necessary.
